WHAT HAPPENS AT A CLINIC?

Parent or legal guardian completes a permission form that is retained by the clinic

Parent completes a basic information sheet which is input electronically then transferred to a CD*

No information about any child is kept by the event providers or the volunteers

Each child progresses through the various identification stations with their parents to complete the ID kit

Parents take ALL of the information home with them
